It is ideal for filling and leveling surfaces prior to the installation of carpeting, vinyl floor tile, and more.

APPLICATION

- 1. Surface must be clean, dry, structurally sound and free of all foreign material.
- 2. Using a broad knife or a smooth face trowel, apply the Floor Patch and Leveler directly to the area to be filled.
- 3. Apply up to ¼ inch and let dry approximately 6 hours to a hard finish (longer in cooler & humid conditions. For thickness greater than ¼ inch, apply in multiple coats allowing each coat to dry completely between applications.
- 4. Feather edge all applications to ensure a smooth surface. Product can not be sanded smooth.
- 5. Maximum application depth is $\frac{3}{4}$ of an inch.

TECHNICAL DATA SHEET

 Test for dryness by pressing a coin to patch. No indentation typically indicates sufficient dry time for floor covering application. Dry time will increase with thickness of patch, lower temperature and/or higher moisture.

NOTE: DAP[®] Flexible Floor Patch and Leveler is not intended to be traffic surface, likewise, paint application is not recommended to create a traffic surface.
