Junk Drawer Organizer



Everybody has an embarrassing junk drawer in desparate need of organization. Here is a simple, inexpensive project you can do in an afternoon to give your junk drawer some much needed love.

Items Needed:

Saw - we used a miter saw but a table saw, jig saw or hand saw would work as well RapidFuse

Clamps

Ruler

2" x 1/2" craft boards - the number or length you need will depend on the size of your drawer

INSTRUCTIONS

First, measure your drawer. This drawer was 19" x 18". Then cut a piece of paper (or tape several peices together) in the exact size of your drawer.



Lay out all the things you want to fit in the drawer on the piece of paper. Try different configurations, keeping in mind things you use the most that you may want at the front of the drawer for easy access. Once you have everything laid out the way you want, use a ruler to draw straight lines around each section.



Use your paper template to decide how long to cut each board. Don't forget to include the thickness of the boards in your final measurement when you have perpendicular pieces!



Apply a generous amount of RapidFuse to the ends of each of your boards and clamp them tightly in place for at least 30 minutes.



Once dry, slide into your drawer and set items in their designated sections. Done!
